


Big Vegie Crunch: Today our school joined hundreds of schools across NSW to attempt to break the record for the most students simultaneously crunching vegetables.

In the classroom: In Maths this week, Jen's class explored measurement and the magnificent metric system, while Nicky's class used structures to count large numbers. In Science, the children had fun with elastic bands while learning about potential and kinetic energy, which will lead to the building of catapults next week. In History, we continued our investigation into local history and we were all amazed by our discovery that, in 1960, the Upper Coopers Creek P&C purchased 12 sticks of gelignite (documented in the P&C minutes)!
