

In the Classroom: In Jen's class in English, we investigated perspectives and anthropomorphism in stories and in Maths we explored the properties of 2 dimensional shapes, particularly quadrilaterals. In Nicky's class, the children explored rhyme, alliteration and similes in English and in Maths they worked on equivalent number sentences. In History, we stepped further back into local history, looking at the lives of Widjabul/ Wia-bal people in the early 1800's and in Science, the children continued work on their catapults. In Mindfulness, the students discussed mindful communication and the importance of activating their hearts, thinking about their words and listening without interrupting.


